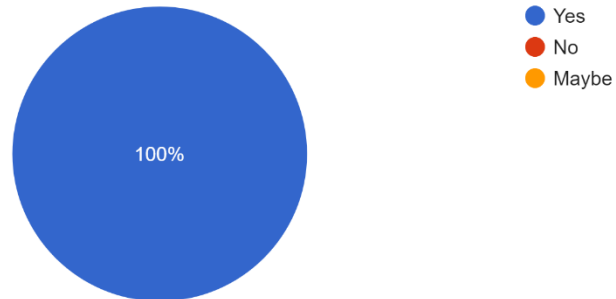


Feedback for GWM Tutor Training - Level 1, Batch 2

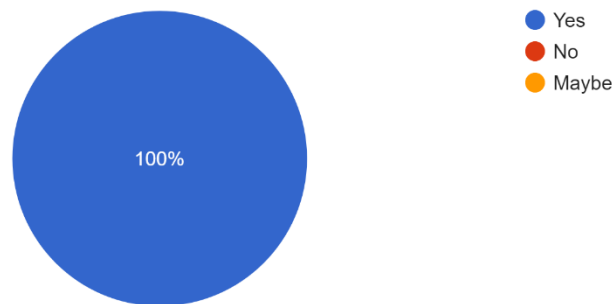
Do you feel confident to apply the techniques taught to your child:

9 responses



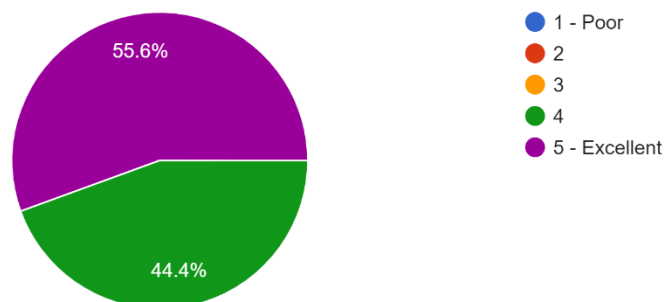
Did the program change your perspective on teaching math:
